Visitations

[Visiting hours] Weekdays : 2 : 00 - 7 : 00 p.m. (Obstetrics Dept. : 3 : 00 - 7 : 00 p.m.) Reception : Until 6 : 50 p.m.
 Saturdays, Sundays and holidays: 1 : 00 - 7 : 00 p.m. (Obstetrics Dept. : 3 : 00 - 7 : 00 p.m.) Reception: Until 6 : 50 p.m.
 (ECU: 2:00 - 7:00 p.m.)

- Please observe the visiting hours so as not to interfere with other hospitalized patients' medical care or disturb their rest. Visits outside the visiting hours must be approved by our medical staff.
- **To prevent infection, visitation is restricted in the following hospital wards depending on the visitor's age : (If you have any questions, please contact us.)**
 - 7th-floor ward, 17th-floor west ward (Pediatric Care Center), ECU: Elementary school-aged children and younger are prohibited.
 - 8th-floor ward, ICU, HCU, CCU : Children under the age of 15 are prohibited.
- Please use the lounge as necessary so as not to interfere with other patients' treatments.
- Visits may not be allowed or visiting hours may be arranged separately depending on the patient's condition or treatment.
- If you have symptoms such as a cough or fever, or if diarrhea or infection is suspected, please refrain from visiting our hospital.
- We may ask that you refrain from visiting our hospital during an outbreak of a disease such as influenza, norovirus, or measles.
- To prevent infection, fresh flowers cannot be brought into the hospital.
- Visiting hours may be changed in the event of infectious diseases, etc.

Visitation procedure

○ When visiting a patient, be sure to fill in the required information on the ward visitor form, receive a visit card, and wear the card during your entire visit.

Those not wearing a card may not be allowed to visit patients.

(Be sure to return the visit card and family card lent by the hospital before you leave.)

[Where to request visitation]

Weekdays : 2 : 00 - 5 : 00 p.m. ⇒ Nurse station on each ward

Weekdays: After 5:00 p.m., Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, including New Year's ⇒ Disaster Control Center on the 1st basement floor of the hospital

※ This procedure is not required for those with a family card visiting a patient during visiting hours.

※ Our hospital staff may also approach you outside the visiting hours even if you have a family card with you.
