## To inpatients, family members, and visitors

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, no visitors are admitted to the wards to visit inpatients. In addition, inpatients are not allowed to stay overnight or go out.

Be sure to wear a face mask when inpatients move from their beds.

We would appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

### ■ Before visiting the hospital, please check the following:

1. Please measure your body temperature before visiting.
2. Please do not visit the hospital if you have symptoms such as fever (above 37.5°C), cough/sputum, tiredness, nausea, or diarrhea.  
Visiting hours are from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. for inpatients.
3. Inpatients may have ONE visitor during visiting hours.  
\*Only ONE person may visit per day.  
\*No visitors under the age of 15 are permitted.  
\*Visitors must bring a face mask and wear it.
4. Before entering the ward, please disinfect your hands and fingers.
5. Up to two attendants can accompany the patient to the doctor for consultation.
6. Only one person is allowed to wait outside the operating room.  
He/she needs to talk with the ward supervisor about the waiting area, etc.  
(Wait outside the hospital ward or contact by cellular phone.)
7. Please refrain from entering the hospital room or the day room
